12:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. – Trip to the Palatinate region including Speyer with cathedral, Trifels castle, St. Martin (tour of the town and vineyard) and wine tasting

9:30 p.m./10:00 p.m. – Arrival in Heidelberg

Please note that you will need some cash to buy your dinner and some snacks in the evening. There will be no lunch break (only dinner). Therefore, we suggest to pick up some sandwiches and drinks at a bakery in Heidelberg before leaving at noon.

We suggest all participating doctoral students to purchase a CampusCard from our student assistants. The CampusCard will be necessary to buy food and beverage at the Mensa (University Cafeteria) which will help to keep your personal expenses low.

Dining halls in Heidelberg

Zeughaus-Bufferet in the Marstall

Under the century-old vaulted ceiling of the Zeughaus, we combine modern catering with a trendy atmosphere - we turned the gloomy halls of the former Marstall dining hall into one big, bright room with a unique lighting concept and a modern, high-end interior. In the east wing, the free-flow-counters offer the visitors a large selection of cold and warm meals: from crisp salads, Italian pasta, vegetables and meat dishes to fresh crabs; sometimes Mediterranean, sometimes Swabian, sometimes Asian or even Creole. The prices in the Zeughaus are simply calculated by weight (same as with all free-flow-buffets). Smoking is not allowed!

Probably the longest bar in the Old Town of Heidelberg is found in the west wing of the former Marstall Mensa - and student staff is found behind it. Here, exhibitions and cultural events are as frequent as live big-screen showings of football games. 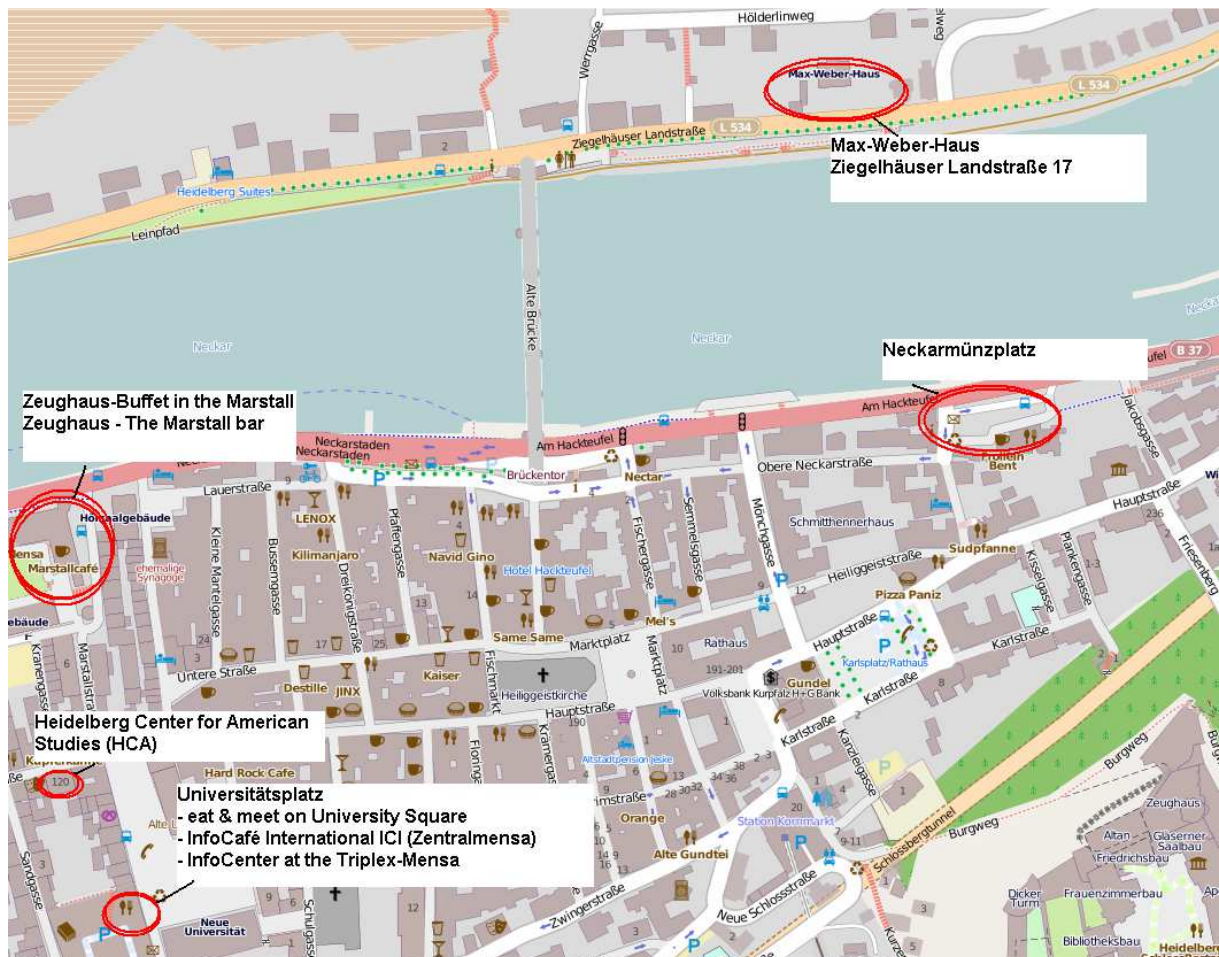
